

Item 24 – Clerks’ Report May 2024

Everton Rec Car Park Lining – completed and is being used correctly:

Insurance claims –

1. Height barrier is complete – insurance monies received and barrier replaced.
2. 15 Charnock Close – damaged perimeter wall: council is not liable.

Everton Rec/ Greenmead Ave oak tree - residents are concerned about an oak tree overhanging property. The tree was inspected by NFDC in January this year and the officer recommended some deadwood removal, which has been done. The Clerks have visited the site and spoken with the residents and subsequently with the NFDC Tree Officer. He does not recommend removal of overhanging limbs as this will be detrimental to the tree’s health. He will inspect again when he is in the area and will plan a subsequent visit in the autumn to check for any fungal growth.



Wildflower bed at Ashley Lane - The Groundsman has laid this out and will seed this week. SGN may come in June/ July to do work at the Memorial Gardens (3 cornered garlic removal).

Cricket pitch at Hordle Rec – Topsoil has been laid and seeded.
