**22/10625.** This application was discussed and **Parish 4.** We recommend refusal. **Resolved Unanimous.** The Parish Council felt this was an overly large extension which was out of keeping with the area and would negatively impact on the street scene. The proposed development was very close to the boundary and the design – especially the juliette balcony - would negatively impact on the neighbours affecting their privacy and light. Councillors Sambrook and Spreadbury offered to attend planning committee if needed.

**22/10855.** It was noted that an application for 10 houses had already been approved for this site and that this application sought to vary the layout of the site and in particular the footpath. **Parish 5** We would accept the decision of the planning officers. **Resolved Unanimous** 

**22/10915.** This application was discussed, and it was felt that it was a poor application with some of the detail in terms of measurements missing. **Parish 2.** We recommend refusal but would accept the decision of the Planning Officers under their delegated powers. **Resolved Unanimous.** The Parish Council is concerned that this is an overly large development on a small space and is poorly designed. It would extend beyond the building line of the rest of Stopples Lane to the rear and have a negative impact on the neighbours' outlook and privacy.

**TPO 22/0369.** It was agreed that the decision was to be left to the Tree Officer with a note added that the Parish council feels that some reduction away from the property was acceptable but that the integrity of the tree should be preserved as it has high amenity value.

**TPO 22/0375.** It was agreed that the decision was to be left to the Tree Officer. However as this was a very visible site could a condition be attached that some replacement planting of a new pine and some quick growing silver birch trees be included.

**TPO 22/0384.** It was agreed that the decision was to be left to the Tree Officer. However, works could be restricted to low branches as the tree has high amenity value.

**22/00509.** A previous application had approved 10 units for this site – this application is for 3 additional units. **Parish 2.** We recommend refusal but would accept the decision of the Planning Officers under their delegated powers. **Resolved Unanimous.** The Parish Council is concerned about the siting of the 3 additional units adjacent to Vaggs Lane. They feel this is out of keeping with the rural open feel of the lane and will be visually intrusive as they are in front of the building line.

- 22/00251. The Parish Council don't have any additional evidence in relation to this.
- 22/00529. The Parish Council don't have any additional evidence in relation to this.

**22/00555.** This application was discussed and **Parish 1.** We recommend permission but would accept the decision of the planning officers under their delegated powers. **Resolved Unanimous.**

**Appeal - Application No: 21/11637** Site: LAND REAR OF 9-23 SKY END LANE, HORDLE SO41 0HJ Description: Erect 6 dwellings utilising existing access from Sky End Lane; demolition of existing buildings (Outline application with details only of access and scale). Consider whether the Parish Council want to make further written representation. This was discussed and it was agreed that our earlier recommendation for refusal should be submitted directly to the independent inspector.
