Planning matters:

21/11272. This application was discussed and **Parish 1**. We recommend permission but would accept the decision of the Planning Officers under their delegated powers. **Resolved Unanimous.**

21/11384. This application was discussed and **Parish 1**. We recommend permission but would accept the decision of the Planning Officers under their delegated powers. **Resolved Unanimous.**

TPO/21/0488. The Tree Warden report indicated no concerns with this application. Decision to be left to the Tree Officers. **Resolved Unanimous.**

TPO/21/0476. The Council noted the Tree Warden Report and voted to return the following objection: *The Parish Council strongly objects to this Tree Work Application.*

The trees form an important part of the streetscene in this area and have high amenity value – they are a historic feature of the village. In addition, their loss would erode the small copse, which is an important haven for wildlife. **Resolved Unanimous.**

TPO/21/0506. The Tree Warden report indicated no concerns with this application. Decision to be left to the Tree Officers. **Resolved Unanimous.**

TPO/21/0513. The Council noted the Tree Warden Report and voted to return the following comment: The Parish Council would like to see a small-scale trim of this tree rather than a large reduction as it has an important amenity value in the area and should be carefully managed and protected. **Resolved Unanimous. TPO/21/0508.** The Council heard this application as the deadline falls before the next meeting. The Council noted the Tree Warden's report and had no concerns about this application. **Resolved Unanimous.**

Appeal APP/B1740/W/21/3278116 - Land rear of, Maylands, 98 Ashley Lane, Hordle SO41 0GA. The Council resolved to resubmit their objection to the Planning Inspectorate. **Resolved Unanimous.**

12. To consider Health and Safety Issues.

The Following Health & Safety issues were identified:

- Wooden posts in the car park adjacent to the WI Hall in Hordle are no longer reflective. Cllr Horne to liaise with office.
- Fir Tree branch has been dumped at the War Memorial Green, Hordle. Groundsman to remove.
- Hedge at corner of Heath Road and Stopples Lane is overgrown. Office to report to HCC.
- Car has been abandoned on Ashley Lane. Office to report to NFDC.

13. To receive a report from the HPMC concerning plans for the Pavilion – Cllr Hill.

Plans submitted. AGM called but not quorate, alternative date in December. Alterations hoped to be complete by February. Parish Office to progress lease. HCA Accounts made available to Parish Council. PAT, electrical testing complete, Legionella testing progressing. **Reported noted.**

14. To receive a report from the ECA rep - Cllr Rook.

Christmas concert on 12th December with limited audience. Christmas lights competition to be run by ECA. Open Gardens event to be investigated. Orchard queries have ben answered. Lights and tree permission applied for from HCC. **Reported noted.**

15. To receive a report from the Golden Hill Working Party – Cllr James.

Bulbs planted on green adjacent to information board. Good turnout of volunteers. Glades to be created. Cllr James to forward working party dates to office for publication. **Reported noted.**

16. To receive a report from the NF Consultative Panel – Cllr Horne.

White Tailed Eagle reintroduction on IOW has been successful. 25 birds introduced with only 3 missing. Dispersing over NW Europe. Hen Harrier reintroduction on Salisbury Plain has been less successful. Future Forest Partnership Consultation has now closed. Information on NPA website. **Reported noted.**

17. To consider a response to the NPA consultation on pop up campsites.

The Council noted the consultation and agreed to support the recommendations from the NPA. **Resolved unanimous.**

18. To review the project list for 2022/23 and agree the budget setting process for 2022/23.

The Project list was previously circulated and the Clerk outlined the contents with the addition of investigating an upgrade to the CCTV system at Hordle Pavilion. The list was agreed and the Clerk will work up the 2022/23 budget and precept on this basis. **Resolved unanimous.**

19. To receive the Clerk's report and correspondence.

The Clerk highlighted the request from Bashley Cricket Club to share Hordle Recreation Ground pitch next summer. All Councillors are invited to attend the Remembrance Service at the War Memorial on 14th November. Clerks to meet with Cllr Spreadbury and the Church to look at the orientation of the service. Parish Office to source a wreath (ideally in the colours for animals and people) for the Tiptoe service at 3pm on the 14th. Also the meeting with HCC Officers at the Heath Road – Ashley footpath, which should see volunteers cutting back vegetation in the coming months and a new waymarker sign. Grant funding for the surfacing was to be investigated too. The Clerk also reported that an interim audit had been scheduled for November. Report noted.
