Full Fibre Broadband Comes To The Parish

At its meeting in April, a representative from Wessex Internet outlined its plans to roll out full fibre broadband to homes and residents in Hordle parish before September 2024. Wessex has been awarded the Government contract for connecting smaller rural settlements. We have become aware that 2 other companies have subsequently arrived and are also doing works.
