## **New Councillor Co-opted**

The Parish Council is pleased to welcome Steve Vincent as a new councillor. Steve Vincent is a resident of Hordle and has a background in facilities management in the private and public sectors. Steve is keen to make a difference to our community and you can contact him via the parish office.

## **Annual Parish Assembly**

The Annual Parish Assembly took place on 14<sup>th</sup> May. As well as a presentation from the police about how to keep safe online, we recognised residents who had gone above and beyond for our community. This year we gave certificates to Margaret Maggs, who for the past 10 years, has co-ordinated bookings for the Hordle Drivers Group, who ferry people to and from medical appointments. We also recognised Toby Gore, Tony Monks and Gary Parsons for their longstanding contribution to grassroots football through Hordle Spurs and Frank Dyson who is a stalwart volunteer delivering food parcels to vulnerable Everton residents.

#### **Grants For Local Charities and Groups**

The Parish Council awarded a grant of £500 to the Young Farmers Club for new stainless steel kitchen tables in the refurbished hall, to enable the group to have cookery demonstrations. The Council also awarded £300 for the You Trust, who teach life skills to people with learning difficulties in the parish and £300 to Hordle Volunteer Drivers Group.

## Full Fibre Broadband Comes To The Parish

At its meeting on in April, a representative from Wessex Internet outlined its plans to roll out full fibre broadband to homes and residents in Hordle parish before September 2024.
